Vision Quest for Women August 6–15, 2009

The vision quest is an ancient rite of passage that begins with a deep personal calling to leave one's daily life behind and return to the earth for renewal, guidance, and clarity. Your ten-day journey begins by living in community close to the earth and culminates in a four-day period of solitude that includes traditional elements of fasting and living in harmony with the natural world. Through self-reflection, ceremony, and the mirror of nature, you will seek your soul's truth to bring balance, renewal, and wisdom to your life.
